It is the policy of Piedmont Technical College to prohibit the unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispersion, possession, or use/abuse of narcotics, drugs, or other controlled substances and alcohol on campus. Piedmont Technical College and its employees will also comply with applicable Federal and State laws and regulations, including the Drug Free Workplace Act of 1988. The College will provide drug-free awareness programs for employees regarding both illegal and legal drug use, including alcohol.

The President, however, may authorize the use of alcoholic beverages for specific events on any campus and/or at official college functions. Guidelines for the use of alcohol can be found in PTC Procedure 8-7-1050.1 Use of Alcoholic Beverages and Illegal Drugs.
