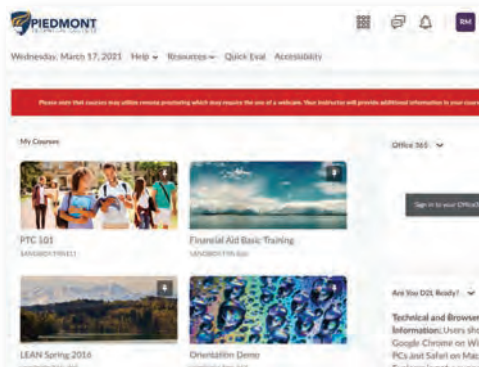
## PTC Pathway

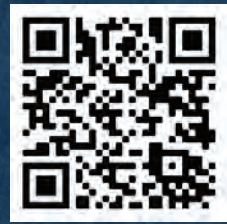
