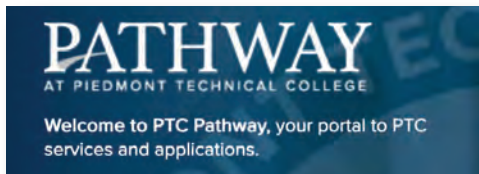

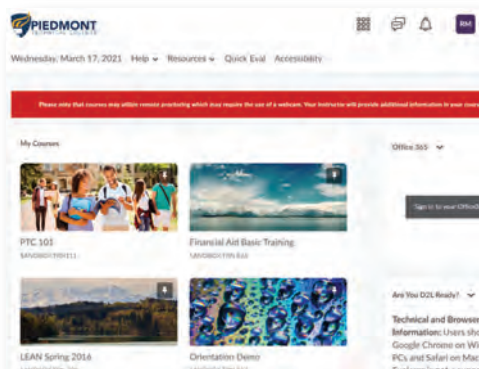
PTC Pathway

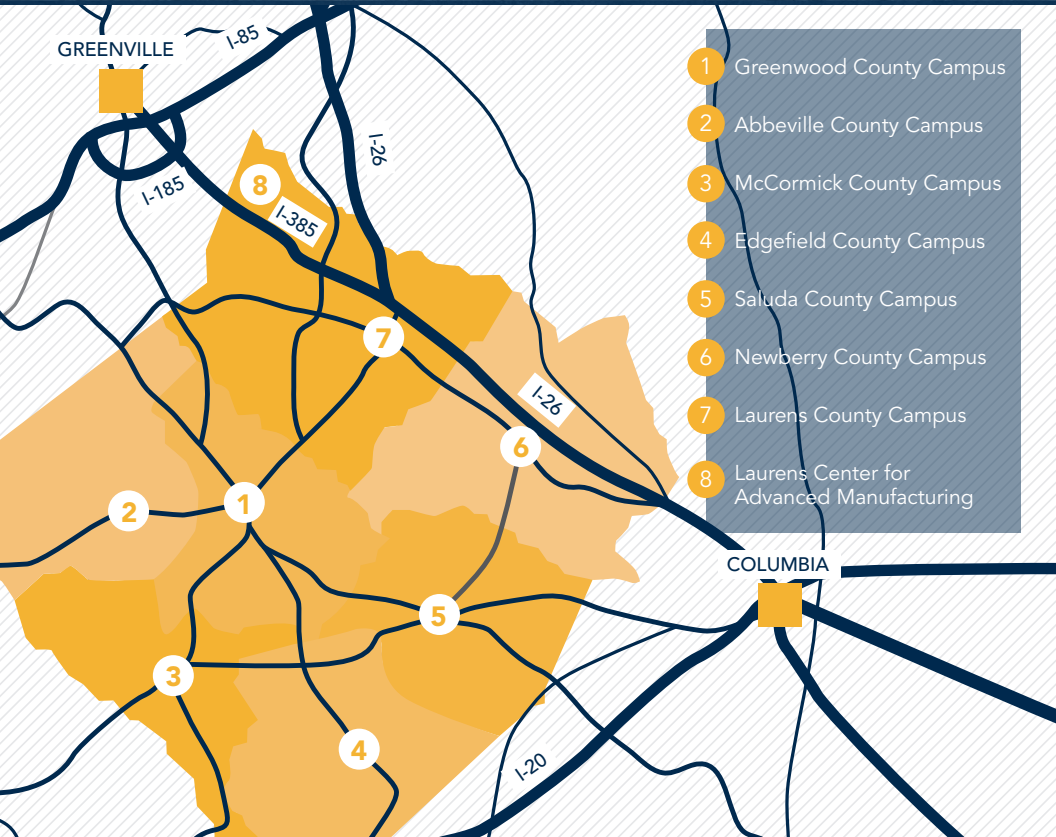

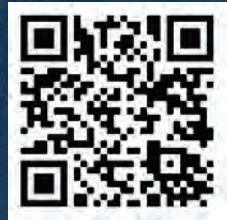
