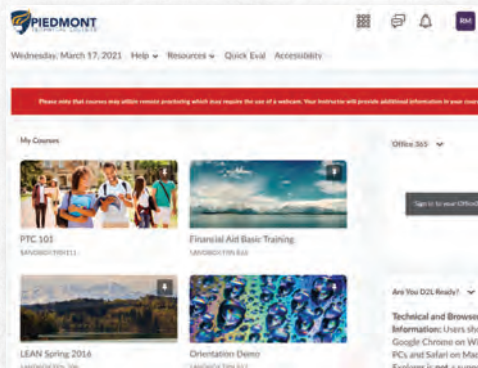
PTC Pathway

PTC Pathway is your gateway to online college services and allows you to access important information as well as a number of college services.



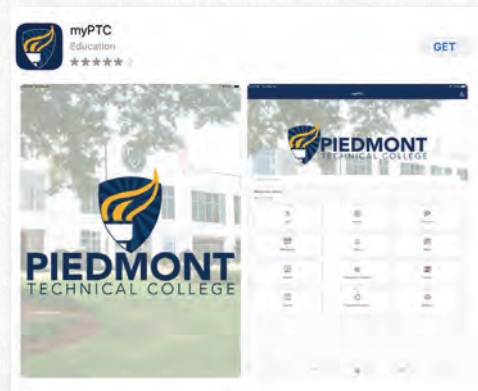
Brightspace (D2L)

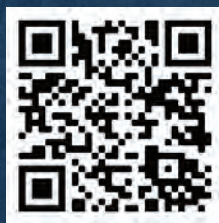
