

Ability-to-Benefit Guidelines

Ability to benefit from formal education:

Applicants for admission to programs leading to an associate degree or diploma must be at least 18 and possess either a high school diploma, a GED, or acceptable scores on the college's placement test:

	ASSET	COMPASS
Minimum score on reading:	30	36

Ability-to-benefit minimums for receiving PELL funding:

Students entering without a high school diploma or GED must demonstrate the ability to benefit by meeting the following minimum score requirements:

	Reading	Writing	Math (numerical score)
ASSET	35	35	33
COMPASS	62	32	25

Note: These minimum scores must be attained during one testing session.
