

2008-2009 Dual Enrollment Tuition

***SUBJECT TO CHANGE FOR 2009-2010**

- State Law requires a student to be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours per semester to be eligible for Lottery Tuition Assistance (LTA).
- Costs of textbooks are extra, and may be charged to the student.
- In ALL cases, it costs less for a student to enroll in 2 courses, than in 1 course, due to LTA.

1. Courses taken at the high school in a 6 credit hour block (usually 2 classes):
