- During the registration process, students will receive a schedule. To view the tuition amount due, log in to PTC Pathway at pathway.ptc.edu.
- Once registration is entered, the student becomes responsible for tuition and fees. If a student decides not to attend, it is the student's responsibility to drop classes as soon as possible or at least prior to the beginning of the term. Failure to do so may create a tuition debt on the student's account.
