

Fact Sheet for the Associate Degree in Nursing

Eligibility Requirements

Minimum Eligibility (Program-Ready) Requirements:

1. Completion, with a grade awarded, of the following courses:
 - Anatomy and Physiology I (BIO 210)
 - English Composition I (ENG 101)
 - Probability and Statistics (MAT 120)
 - General Psychology (PSY 201)
2. Minimum program ready GPA, in the 4 program ready courses must average 2.5.

3. A score of 65% in both the math and reading sections of the HOBET V

Additional General Education Coursework:

Complete Anatomy and Physiology II (BIO 211) and a Fine Arts/Humanities elective (recommend completion prior to program entry).

Minimum Grade Requirement:

All program-ready and general education courses required for the ADN program must be completed with the grade of C or better. Students must have a PTC overall GPA of 2.0 or better to apply.

When and How to Apply

The Nursing program accepts 32 students to begin the clinical program twice a year; fall and spring semesters. Applications are accepted in May and September.

Additional Information

Meeting the minimum requirements for clinical entry does not guarantee acceptance. After review of all applicants, the 32 students with the highest score will be offered acceptance. In the event of a tie, the student with the earliest priority date will be selected. All applicants will be notified via post mail of the Nursing Division's decision.

Students accepted to this program will be required to pass a background check and drug screen upon acceptance.
