Eligibility Requirements

Minimum Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Completion, with a grade awarded, of the following courses:
 - Anatomy and Physiology I (BIO 210)
 - English Composition I (ENG 101)
 - Intermediate Algebra (MAT 102), Probability and Statistics (MAT 120), or an approved higher level math course
 - General Psychology (PSY 201)
- 2. The grades of the above courses must equate to a minimum 2.5 GPA
- 3. A score of 65% in both the math and reading sections of the HOBET V

Additional Recommendations:

- 1. Complete Anatomy and Physiology II (BIO 211) and a Fine Arts/Humanities elective prior to application
- 2. Take these additional courses for better success in the program:
 - Medical Terminology (AHS 102)
 - Clinical Computations (AHS 107)
 - Microbiology (BIO 225)
 - Chemistry (CHM 110 and 111)
 - English Composition II (ENG 102) and an English literature

When and How to Apply

The Nursing program accepts 32 students to begin the clinical program twice a year; fall and spring semesters. Applications are accepted in May and September.
