Kevin: The specification specifies a Daktronics model and does not indicate that an "or equal" is acceptable. Daktronics competes against us across the United States and I have bid numerous projects in South Carolina. Since this is a State project is an or equal is acceptable for this project?

I ran across a project where you all are requesting a quote for an electronic message center that bids on 1/24/2014. The Dodge reports indicate this is a Daktronics brand unit. If so, are you accepting substitutions or it there a specific Daktronics model that you are looking for? Please let me know how I can obtain the bid documents for this project as I would appreciate the opportunity to provide you a proposal.

Does the LED unit have to be a Daktronics unit or can it be equivalent or better?

By two single sided units, do you mean to create one sign with the units back to back? Or will each unit be installed on separate signs?

Units will be back to back – on one sign

Do you know the distance between the sign and computer that will be used to program the sign and is it line of sight?

Less than 1000 ft – direct line of site.

I have a question pertaining to the above bid for the Daktronics LED sign for Abbeville. On page 3, you state Product Support 10 years. Can you clarify what you mean by product support. Is this technical phone support or labor warranty support?
