

**Transfer/Partnership Agreement
Between
Anderson University
And
Piedmont Technical College**

Transfer Guidelines

Anderson University (AU) and Piedmont Technical College (PTC) agree to the following policy for transfer of PTC graduates. This agreement shall become effective when signed by the presidents of each institution, and will continue until such time as it is modified by mutual consent or cancelled by either institution. Cancellation will require written notification.

Only courses with a grade of C or higher will transfer. Remedial courses (courses numbered 100 and below) will not be accepted as transfer credit.

For courses transferred to AU, a maximum of 64 semester hours will be applied toward graduation.

PTC students wishing to transfer to AU should sign the AU Transfer Agreement. A signed AU Transfer Agreement will guarantee the student rights to the AU catalog in effect as of the date on the agreement. The student must also meet the following requirements:

- Maintain continuous enrollment, excluding summers, at PTC
- Enroll in AU within two semesters of completing studies at PTC

An AU advisor can assist PTC students and advisors in selecting appropriate courses to transfer to AU. Students who break enrollment at PTC and re-enter at a later date must sign a new AU Transfer Agreement in order to regain AU catalog rights.

AU reserves the right to alter a specific degree program for content. If a degree program is altered, PTC students will be given the same considerations as AU students in regards to meeting curriculum requirements. This guarantee is null and void if the chosen degree program is terminated at AU.
