

**Articulation Agreement
between
Piedmont Technical College's
Associate in Agriculture, Major in Horticulture program
and
Clemson University's
Horticulture and Turfgrass Bachelor programs**

Clemson University and Piedmont Technical College do hereby enter into agreement to provide a 2+2 transfer program from the Piedmont Technical College Associate in Agriculture, Major in Horticulture into the Clemson University Horticulture and/or Turfgrass Bachelor's degree programs, effective fall 2006.

Piedmont Technical College Degree Program: Associate in Agriculture, Major in Horticulture

Clemson University Degree Programs: Bachelor of Science in Horticulture and
Bachelor of Science in Turfgrass

Effective Date: Fall semester, 2006

Graduates of Piedmont Technical College with the Associate Degree in Agriculture, Major in Horticulture with transfer option in Horticulture and/or Turfgrass, who complete their degree with a GPR of 2.5 or higher, may apply for transfer admission to Clemson University in Horticulture and/or Turfgrass.

No course may be transferred to Clemson University from Piedmont Technical College as a substitute for any 300-400 level courses.

A grade of C or higher is required for the transfer of any course. Therefore, Clemson University will consider for transfer from Piedmont Technical College any course shown on the official transcript where credit is recorded and certified as having been met at a level of "C" or higher. Quality points from transfer courses will not be considered in the calculation of the grade point ratio (GPR) at Clemson.

Upon admission, an appointment with the Horticulture program chair will culminate in:

- (a) the appointment of an advisor in the area of specialization.
- (b) a program of needed courses leading to a Bachelor of Science degree in Horticulture and/or Turfgrass.
- (c) no repetition of courses credited from Piedmont Technical College which meets the guidelines stated above.

Key faculty and administrators shall review this agreement on a regular basis.

The two attached documents outline: 1) specific courses to be taught and 2) Piedmont Technical College transfer course number and the corresponding Clemson equivalent course number.
