## Program Overview

The Health Science Transfer program provides the general education competencies students need as a basis on which to build technical knowledge and skills in a variety of health care careers. By working closely with an advisor, students can select options in Dental Hygiene, Physical Therapy Assistant or Medical Laboratory Technician. Successful completion of the core requirements and the selected advising option will qualify students to be considered for a one-plus-one program leading to an Associate in Applied Science degree at Greenville Technical College.

All Phase 1 courses are to be completed at Piedmont Technical College. The student will then complete the application/weighted admissions form for Phase 2 of the program which is completed at Greenville Technical College.

All students should contact Lenette Thompson to discuss the importance of attending a Career Talk, completing the volunteer hours, taking the TEAS V Test, and having all Phase 1 courses completed by a spring semester to submit the application/weighted admissions form.

Greenville Technical College only accepts 2 students the fall of each year from Piedmont Technical College in each of the following programs.

## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

### Dental Hygiene Transfer Program

This One-Plus-One program with Greenville Technical College, produces dental assistants and hygienists who are well-prepared for the workforce, thanks to a combination of classroom instruction, technology that supports what they are learning, and hands-on experiences. In a simulation lab, students practice hand instrumentation on dental tooth models, which provide excellent experience prior to treating patients. Human patient simulators in the college's Simulation Technologies and Training Center help prepare graduates to handle the unexpected, as they practice responses to patient emergency situations.

### Physical Therapy Assistant Transfer Program

This One-Plus-One program with Greenville Technical College, prepares graduates to become a licensed PTA who can work in the field of physical therapy, under the supervision of a licensed Physical Therapist, as an integral member of the health care team. A PTA can work in hospitals, rehabilitation centers, school systems, home health care, private practice, health clubs and academia. Physical Therapist Assistants provide physical therapy interventions that help patients reduce their pain, minimize their physical impairments, improve movement and function, prevent illness or injury and promote optimal physical health.

Over 70% of medical decisions made by physicians are based on information obtained from lab tests. This information comes from the work of the medical laboratory technician, a vital part of the health care team, performing a full range of tests in hematology, chemistry, microbiology and blood banking, and helping to diagnose a variety of diseases and blood disorders.
