



Fact Sheet for EMT-Basic

• Pre-requisite Courses:

- RDG 100 Critical Reading or placement test score equivalent
- MAT 032/012 Developmental Mathematics & Workshop or placement test score equivalent
- Work Keys scores of 5 on Reading for Information, 4 for Locating Information and 4 for Applied Mathematics would satisfy pre-requisites.
- Notes:
 - Prior completion of college level English would satisfy the pre-requisite.
 - Prior completion of college-level math would satisfy the math pre-requisite.

• Registration Process

- Students should contact the Continuing Education Health Care Program Manager prior to registration.
- Students who meet the prerequisite course requirements may register for EMT classes on a first come, first served basis

• Program Limits, Location and Duration

- Up to 14 students
- Location varies based on community demand

Additional Notes:

- EMT-Basic is not eligible for Title IV Financial Aid
- Eligible students may receive Lottery Tuition Assistance
- FAFSA is not required; FAFSA Waiver may be submitted for LTA only
