NOTE: In order to complete the Embalmer's Certificate, you **MUST** provide proof that you are currently working at a funeral home. The practicum portion of the program will be completed under the direct supervision of the licensed embalmer at the funeral home. Therefore, we must have confirmation from the owner/manager granting you permission to complete your ten-practicum cases at that location. If your practicum is conducted in South Carolina a student embalmer's permit from the SC LLR Funeral Board is required.

Student pursuing the Embalmer's Certificate should meet with Dedrick Gantt, Nancy Wilkie, or David Martin for advisement unless they require developmental or transitional coursework prior to beginning the FSE courses.
