GROUND RULES ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

- It's a prerequisite for this course that you have the ability to ride a bicycle. If you haven't ridden a bicycle in a few years or have never ridden one, please either refresh your skills or learn to ride a bicycle prior to attending class.
- > The class will start on time and will stay on schedule. If you miss a classroom session or range exercise, you will not be permitted to actively continue with the riding sessions. A tuition refund will not be issued. NOTE: Picture taking or observing this class by unofficial personnel is strictly prohibited.
- You are required to wear the following protective clothing during EVERY riding session:
 - A DOT approved helmet (some are available for your use). *Half Coverage helmets are prohibited*!
 - Eye protection, i.e., face-shield, sunglasses, goggles, glasses
 - Long sleeve shirt or jacket
 - Long pants, preferably jeans or leather
 - Over the ankle foot wear, not cloth or canvas. (Heels over one inch are not suitable.)
 - Full finger gloves

You will not be permitted to participate in any range session without proper protective gear.

- Instructors will strive to provide a safe and orderly environment. Students behaving in a reckless, disrespectful, or unruly manner will be dropped from the class at the Instructor's discretion. Impairment of any form is strictly prohibited. A tuition refund will not be issued.
- You will be learning to ride in a group environment. Instructors will do their best to provide individual coaching and instruction to each student. However, time is limited and the Instructors must keep the class on schedule.
- > South Carolina's Technical College Beginning Motorcycling Class takes a building block approach to learning to ride a motorcycle. Each exercise builds on the skills, knowledge, and confidence acquired in the previous exercises. If you are unable to consistently achieve exercise objectives, the Instructor will counsel you out of the class. A tuition refund will not be issued.
- It is natural to be nervous about learning to ride a motorcycle. While some fear is to be expected, excessive fear can lead to tenseness and ultimately to mistakes on the riding range. If the Instructor perceives that you have an excessive amount of fear and are a danger to yourself or other students, the Instructor will counsel you out of the course. A tuition refund will not be issued.
- You are expected to follow directions provided by the Instructors. Failing to following instructions repeatedly may be grounds for dismissal by the Instructor. A tuition refund will not be issued.
- There will be a written and riding assessment administered at the end of the class. You must pass both assessments to obtain a class completion card. The Instructor's decision is final with respect to whether you have passed or failed an assessment. *Retests are not authorized!* Our goal is for you to have fun while learning basic motorcycling skills and to assist you in deciding if motorcycling is for you. Insurance companies are authorized to provide a discount.
