

Fact Sheet for Patient Care Technician (Effective Fall 2020)

Pre-requisite Courses:

- RDG 100 – Critical Reading or placement test score equivalent
- ENG 100 – Introduction to Composition or placement test score equivalent
- MAT 032/012 – Developmental Mathematics & Workshop or placement test score equivalent
- Note: Prior completion of ENG 101 or ENG 165 would satisfy the reading and English pre-requisite.
- Note: Prior completion of any college-level math course would satisfy the mathematics pre-requisite.

General Education Courses (may be taken while waiting for next program start):

- AHS 163 – Long Term Care
- Exemption credit may be awarded for current C.N.A. certification

Registration Process:

- Students who meet the prerequisite course requirements may register for first semester classes on a first come, first served basis

- AHS 110-Patient Care Procedures (Full term).....2 credit hours
