

Application for the Associates Degree in Nursing

Eligibility Requirements

Minimum Eligibility Requirements:

1. Completion, with a grade awarded, of the following courses:
 - Anatomy and Physiology I (BIO 210)
 - English Composition I (ENG 101)
 - Intermediate Algebra (MAT 102), Probability and Statistics (MAT 120), or an approved higher level math course
 - General Psychology (PSY 201)
2. The grades of the above courses must equate to a minimum 2.5 GPA
3. A score of 65% in both the math and reading sections of the HOBET V

Additional Recommendations:

1. Complete Anatomy and Physiology II (BIO 211) and a Fine Arts/Humanities elective prior to first semester
2. Take these additional courses for better success in the program:
 - Medical Terminology (AHS 102)
 - Clinical Computations (AHS 107)
 - Long Term Care (AHS 163)
 - Microbiology (BIO 225)
 - Chemistry (CHM 106, 110, 111)
 - English Composition II (ENG 102) or an English literature

When and How to Apply

The Nursing program accepts 32 students to begin the clinical program twice a year; fall and spring semesters. Applications are accepted in May and September.

Meeting the minimum requirements for clinical entry does not guarantee acceptance. After review of all applicants, the 32 students with the highest score will be offered acceptance. All applicants will be notified via post mail of the Nursing Division's decision.
