Fact Sheet for Occupational Therapy Assistant

Eligibility Requirements

Minimum Eligibility (Program-Ready) Requirements:

- 1. Completion, with a C or higher, of the following courses:
 - Medical Terminology (AHS 102)
 - Anatomy and Physiology I (BIO 210)
 - English Composition I (ENG 101)
 - Probability and Statistics (MAT 120)
 - General Psychology (PSY 201)
 - Human Growth and Development (PSY 203)
- 2. Minimum program ready GPA, in the 6 program ready courses above, must average 2.5.

- 3. Completion of a minimum of 40 hours of observation in two different occupational therapy settings. The observation form may be downloaded from here and must be submitted DIRECTLY FROM THE OT SUPERVISOR(S). It is recommended that you provide a self-addressed, stamped envelope to the supervisor(s) for ease of submission.

Additional General Education Coursework:

The following additional general education coursework, with a C or higher, is required for this program. Please note that course completion is required for progression as noted:

- Anatomy and Physiology II (BIO 211)
- Public Speaking (SPC 205) must be completed prior to program entry.
- Introduction to Computers (CPT 101) must be completed prior to program entry.
- Elective Humanities/Fine Art must be completed by the end of second semester.

When and How to Apply

The OTA program accepts 24 students to begin the clinical program in the spring semester. Up to half (12) are chosen using the merit application on the reverse. The remaining spots are filled by priority date.

Applications are accepted in September.

Additional Information

Meeting the minimum requirements for clinical entry does not guarantee program acceptance. After review of all merit applicants, the 12 students with the highest score will be offered acceptance. In the event of a tie, the student with the earliest priority date will be selected. All applicants will be notified via postal mail of the Health Science Division's decision.

Students accepted to this program will be required to pass a background check and drug screen upon acceptance.
