

Program Information For Phlebotomy Technician Certificate

Eligibility Requirements

Minimum Eligibility (Program-Ready) Requirements:

1. Completion, with a C or higher, of the following courses:
 - Medical Terminology (AHS 102)
 - English Composition I (ENG 101)
 - Contemporary Mathematics (MAT 155)
 - Introduction to Computers (CPT 101)
2. Overall college GPA must equal 2.0.

When and How to Apply

The Phlebotomy Technician Certificate program accepts 12 students to begin the clinical program in the fall and 12 to begin in spring semester.

Applications are accepted in May for the fall program and September for the spring program. Check the Health Science and Nursing Resources website for the exact dates and deadlines.
