

Fact Sheet for Associate Degree Nursing

Program Ready Coursework:

- BIO 210 – Anatomy and Physiology I
- ENG 101 – English Composition I
- MAT 120 – Probability and Statistics or MAT 110 College Algebra*
- PSY 201 – General Psychology

*Students planning to pursue a BSN after completion of the ADN program should enroll in MAT 120. MAT 120 is required by 4 year BSN programs. If students have completed MAT 120 and MAT 110, the higher of the two grades will be used for calculating the program ready GPA.

Minimum GPA and Course Grade Requirements:

- Minimum of 2.5 in Program Ready Coursework
- Program Ready GPA Calculator can be found at https://websrv.ptc.edu/program_ready_gpa_calc
- Minimum 2.0 Overall PTC GPA
- Minimum grade of C in all Program Ready and General Education Coursework

Testing Requirement:

- **ATI TEAS**
- Minimum score of 65% in Reading
- Minimum score of 65% in Math
- Scores expire after 3 years

Program Location and Duration:

- Greenwood Campus
- Four consecutive semesters after program admission
- Program is 4-5 days a week, in person, during the day. Clinicals may be nights and weekends.

Program Application Process:

- Acceptance into PTC's Associate Degree Program is competitive and limited to:
 - 32 students admitted for spring (January) start
 - Students apply September 1 – 16
 - 32 students admitted for fall start
 - Students apply May 1 - 16
