

Fact Sheet for Practical Nursing

Program Ready Coursework:

- BIO 112 – Basic Anatomy and Physiology*
- ENG 101 – English Composition I
- MAT 120 – Probability and Statistics or MAT 110 College Algebra**
- PSY 201 – General Psychology

*BIO 210 and BIO 211 will substitute for BIO 112, **if** the student successfully completes both BIO 210 and BIO 211 with a grade of “C” in each course. BIO 210 grade will be used to calculate program ready GPA.

**Students planning to pursue a BSN in the future should enroll in MAT 120. MAT 120 is required by 4 year BSN programs. It is recommended that students take BIO 211 prior to program acceptance, but completion is required before the 2nd semester of the accepted health care program.

Minimum GPA and Course Grade Requirements:

- Minimum of 2.5 in Program Ready Coursework
- Program Ready GPA Calculator can be found at https://websrv.ptc.edu/program_ready_gpa_calc
- Minimum 2.0 Overall PTC GPA
- Minimum grade of C in all Program Ready and General Education Coursework

Testing Requirement:

- **ATI TEAS**
- Minimum score of 65% in Reading
- Minimum score of 65% in Math
- Scores expire after 3 years

Program Location and Duration:

- Fall – Greenwood Campus
- Spring – Laurens Campus
- Three semesters after program admission
- Program is 4-5 days a week, in person, during the day. Clinicals may be nights and weekends.

Program Application Process:

- Acceptance into PTC's Practical Nursing program is competitive and limited to:
 - 32 students admitted for spring (January) start in Laurens
 - Students apply September 1 – 16
 - 32 students admitted for fall start in Greenwood
 - Students apply May 1 - 16
