#### Why is my major the Health Care Certificate?

The Health Care Certificate allows pre-health students to take the courses that are required for their desired program (indicated by the track associated with their certificate) within a certificate that includes a skill that could lead to employment.

# Do I have to complete the Health Care Certificate before I can apply for my program?
