Program Location and Duration

- Newberry Campus only
- Labs and clinicals may be off-campus
- One (1) semester; Fall or Spring Start only

Program Entrance Requirements

- This is a direct admit program. There is no secondary application process in place for this major. Courses are offered on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Most program courses have a prerequisite of RDG 100 and ENG 100 or appropriate placement scores. Completion of ENG 101 or higher also covers this prerequisite requirement.
- Student must have a minimum 2.0 GPA
