



## Pharmacy Technician - Program Fact Sheet

- PHM classes are Fall Start only; General Education courses may begin in any semester

### Program Location and Duration

- PHM classes are limited to 20 students starting in the Fall term and are offered on the Greenwood Campus only
- General Education courses may be taken in any semester at any campus or online
- Program is a minimum of three (3) semesters

### Program Entrance Requirements

- This is a direct admit program. There is no secondary application process in place for this major.
- Courses are offered on a first-come, first-served basis.

## Advising Information

- If no seats are available in PHM classes for the current semester, student must wait for the next round of availability. In most cases, this means waiting until the following academic year to begin or resume PHM classes. (NOTE: This does not affect General Education courses)
