



Paramedic Certificate (PMD7) - Program Fact Sheet

Fact Sheets are designed for students and advisors to review program-specific requirements and program application procedures. Please make an appointment with your advisor to discuss your academic goals and progress.

Program Ready Coursework:

- BIO 112 – Basic Anatomy and Physiology, Minimum grade of C

Optional pre-program coursework:

- These courses are not required, but an additional five application points will be awarded for each course completed with a grade of C or higher.
 - AHS 102 – Medical Terminology
 - AHS 155 – Special Topics in Health Care
 - COL 103 – College Skills

Other Program Entrance Requirements:

- Unencumbered, nationally recognized EMT Certification
- Information about health records, physical standards, vaccination, drug testing, and background check requirements is in the Health Care FAQ's and in the Health Care Division Handbook

Minimum GPA and Course Grade Requirements:

- Minimum grade of C in BIO 112
- Minimum 2.0 Overall PTC GPA
- Minimum grade of C in all Program Ready and General Education courses

Program Location and Duration:

- Greenwood Campus
- Three (3) consecutive semesters, including summer, after program admission
- Program is 4-5 days a week, in person, during the day; Clinicals may be nights and weekends

Program Application Process:

- Acceptance into PTC's Paramedic Certificate Program is competitive and limited to:
 - 24 Students admitted for Fall (August) start
 - Students apply May 1-16
 - See Program Worksheet for breakdown of points

Program Coursework:

- The program graduation plan provides a semester-by-semester outline of courses.
- After completion of the Paramedic Certificate, students have the option of progressing to an Associate Degree in General Technology, Paramedic, with completion of additional coursework.
