Minimum GPA and Course Grade Requirements:

- Minimum of 2.5 in Program Ready Coursework

Program Location and Duration:

- Greenwood Campus
- Five consecutive semesters, after program admission
- Program is 4-5 days a week, in person, during the day. Clinicals may be nights and weekends.

Program Application Process:

- Acceptance into PTC's Radiology Technology program is competitive and limited to 20 students to begin fall semester.
