What is a Guided Pathway?

Guided Pathways are designed to provide students with a clear map towards program completion. In the case of Health Care programs, these Pathways are meant to show pre-health students the best path to take to complete the Health Care Certificate.

Why is my major the Health Care Certificate?

The Health Care Certificate allows pre-health students to take the courses that are required for their desired program (indicated by the track associated with their certificate) within a certificate that includes a skill that could lead to employment.

Do I have to complete the Health Care Certificate before I can apply for my program?

No. Admission to clinical Health Care programs is based on completion of specific courses as well as level of competitiveness at time of application. To learn more, please refer to your desired program's Fact Sheet.

What is the advantage of completing the Health Care Certificate?

The Health Care Certificate helps you to earn skills that could lead to an entry-level position within the healthcare field.
