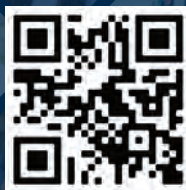

INTRODUCING THE PHOENIX FAST TRACK

We are pleased to share an important update about Piedmont Technical College's ongoing commitment to your success. Beginning Fall 2025, we will introduce the Phoenix Fast Track, a shift to 8-week courses across several programs to offer you **greater flexibility, improved engagement, and accelerated completion pathways**. This initiative is based on extensive research and best practices from other community and technical colleges that have successfully adopted shorter academic terms.

Why the Change?

Colleges that have implemented 8-week courses report significant benefits, including:

- **Higher Student Success Rates:** More students successfully complete courses and persist to the next term.
- **Improved Retention and Graduation:** By focusing on fewer courses at a time, students stay engaged and progress more efficiently.
- **Greater Flexibility:** More frequent start dates allow students to re-enroll quickly if life circumstances interrupt their studies.

The Phoenix Fast Track will be introduced gradually through a Hybrid Rollout. This means that some programs will fully adopt 8-week courses, while others will keep longer formats due to specific clinical or lab needs.

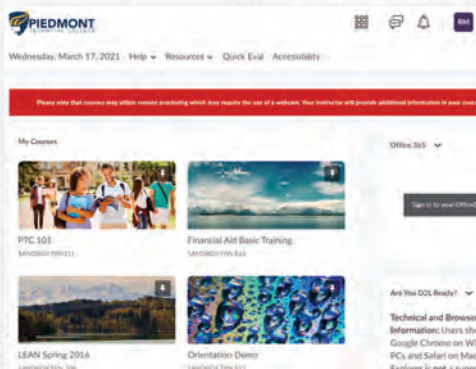
PTC Pathway
