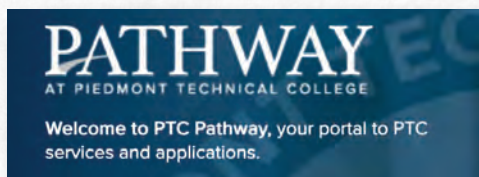

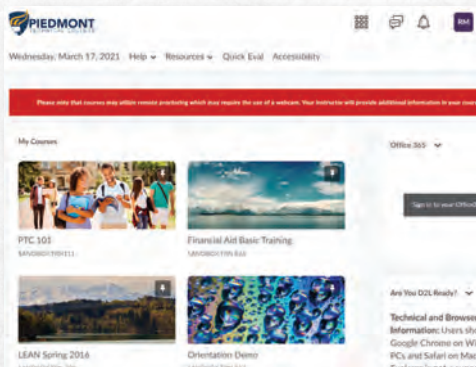
PTC Pathway

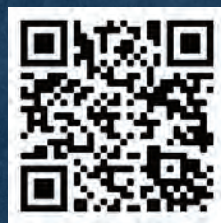


MAP & LOCATIONS
