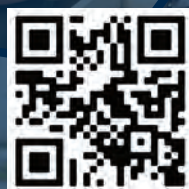

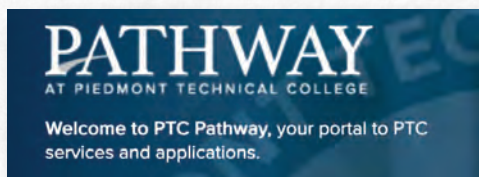

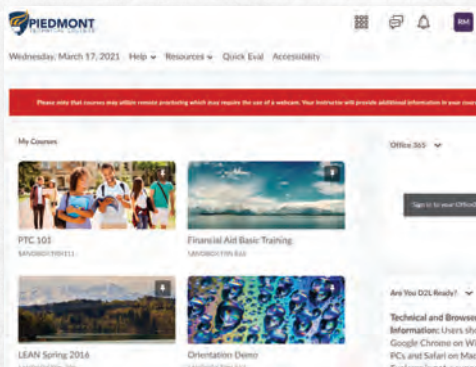
PTC Pathway
