Avery Scholarship Program

In order to help underrepresented freshman and transfer students who have been accepted to CofC fund an excellent education, the College has created the **Avery Scholarship Program**.

There is no application for an Avery Scholarship. Selection is competitive based on a combination of a student's overall academic profile and financial need. Priority will be given to legal residents of South Carolina who have completed a FAFSA by **March 1st**.

Students who have participated in TRIO programs, a CofC bridge program with a SC technical college, or similar programs, will receive strong consideration. Avery scholars may receive **up to \$3,000** for each year of eligibility. In order to renew the scholarship, a student must maintain a 2.75 minimum cumulative GPA, file a FAFSA each year, and complete a minimum of 30 credit hours per year.
