#### PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

#### PHLEBOTOMY TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATE

This certificate program provides students with the basic skills necessary for the collection of laboratory blood specimens. This program is offered in fall and spring semesters with an enrollment of 12 students each semester.

Admission: Health Care programs have special program admission criteria which must be completed prior to applying for the clinical phase of the program. A brief description of program admission options is below. For more detailed information, please go to www.ptc.edu/hsnis.

To become eligible for entry into the Phlebotomy Technician program, applicants must:

- 1. Be at least 18 by the date of program entry
- Complete RDG 100 and ENG 100 or RWR 100, and MAT 032/012 or have appropriate placement scores to register for the first semester classes.

#### Note

- 1. Drug testing and background check will be completed during the first semester.
- 2. Students are required to maintain a current American Heart Association "Basic Life Support" certification throughout the major studies courses.
- 3. Students are required to provide and maintain current immunization records.
- 4. Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA.
